BACKGROUND

Established in 1931 as Brisbane's main international airport, Archerfield Airport is an Australian icon. It was the birthplace of Qantas' first international flight, launched the first international mail service to England, and facilitated the first west-east Pacific Ocean crossing by Sir Charles Kingsford-Smith. General MacArthur also commandeered the site as an air force base for US, British and Australian troops during World War II. The airport has an immense history and an equally exciting future.

As Queensland's major general aviation airport, Archerfield Airport plays a crucial role in the region's aviation network. Situated just 11km southwest of Brisbane's CBD, our recent \$20 million investment into strengthening and lengthening the main runway along with significant lighting upgrades enables improved safety, increased aircraft capacity for 24/7 operations.

Archerfield Airport is embracing a renaissance of new aviation technology and has made strides in modernising facilities for aircraft operations and logistics providers. With over 120,000 flights per year and the highest number of helicopter movements of any Australian airport, we were awarded the Australian Airport Association's Metropolitan Airport of the Year Award in 2021 and again in 2024.

Both hangars will be capable of accommodating a wide range of Code C fixed-wing aircraft with tail heights up to 8.5 meters and door openings up to 40 meters.

These premium hangar facilities are located with road frontage to the major arterial of Beatty Road presenting excellent signage opportunities. Hangar 1 also provides for secure parking and direct airside access to the hangar apron to enable VIP boarding. The fully fire-sprinkled design ensures fueled aircraft can be safely parked internally to enable swift departure. And the proximity to the main runway will have your fleet in the air in no time.

- Jet A1 and Av Gas Fuel Available
